The design Bonetti produced is called Carolle Lines: a creamy lilac-stained paper that bears squiggly vertical lines in tones of silver and gold, available for purchase through Thibaut-Pomerantz and David Gill Gallery for \$550 per roll. Imagine mattress ticking had gone on a bender after too much absinthe, or perhaps a map of Scandinavian wilderness in winter. That twisted sense of chic makes the perfect background for Gill's wild and woolly furniture and lighting (all of which Bonetti designed for the gallery) and Thibaut-Pomerantz's glorious vintage and antique ceramics and wallpapers, works that range from evocative fragments to sections of room-size scenic panoramas. In fact, one of them, a polychrome Art Nouveau wallcovering, is the treasure that set Bonetti on his creative way when it came to this new commission, where the past meets the present with the future well in sight.
